Programme & Course Outcome

B.A. Functional English programme in Sree Krishna College aims to equip the students with proper communication skills in multifaceted applications of English language. The students are taught English language at advanced level, focusing mainly on LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing) skills, with their application in major areas like Media, Business, Creative writing, Translation, Advertising, Film, Sports and Entertainment. The programme helps in fostering human values through exposure to major works of literature in English, stimulating self-exploration and self-expression. Also, moulding a generation of techno-savy students competent in tapping ICT (Information and Communication Technology) for generation of knowledge is another objective of this programme at Sree Krishna College. We follow the Choice Based Credit Semester System of the University of Calicut.
