Decisions

1. As per the new guidelines published by NAAC in June 2022, total no: of metrics (Qualitative/Quantitative)

among various key indicators was reduced from 96 to 56. Hence a restructuring of data collection is necessary for 2022-23 AQAR and next SSR submission for our 3rd cycle of re-accreditation. It was decided to collect data in accordance with these guidelines. For active participation of faculty members in NAAC process, it was decided to assign ~~an~~ each metric to each faculty members during 2022-23.

Decisions

1. Based on the collected data for the results of 2022 passout students result analysis was carried out. QAC has concluded that an immediate measure for the enhancement of ^{the} pass % of students is necessary. Quality circles and

Remedial measures must be implemented effectively. Strengthening of class & PTA activities is also necessary for effective enhancement of pass %

2. The online mode of teaching and focus area study of students during higher secondary level made various issues ⁱⁿ among the learning capacity of student. In order to fill such gap areas it was decided to conduct bridge programme. QAC has decided to conduct a bridge programme for I semester UG and PG students during Nov 2022. It was also decided to direct depts to submit ~~the~~ syllabus of bridge course before 1 November 2022.

3. As per new NAAC guidelines, it is important that how institution try to transform its quality ~~initiatives~~ initiative as per NEP-2020. QAC has discussed this matter in detail. It was decided to promote multidisciplinary research ~~and~~ ~~initiatives~~ activities in the institution. Within the the framework of University curriculum, it was decided ~~to~~ not ~~be~~ easy to provide ^{enough} flexibility on curricula. However, certificate courses in ~~the~~ various depts are framed ~~as~~ in accordance with skill enhancement with a multidisciplinary approach. In order to integrate indian knowledge system and also to transform cultural heritage among students and other stake holders ongoing ~~strategies~~ of Sanskrit, and malayalam depts, ~~like~~ like Varanasi lecture series, ~~transformations~~ ~~has~~ ~~also~~ transfer of knowledges of various arts of forms

of Sree Krishna Temple like Kashnaatam, mural painting etc) has to be strengthened. DGAC has decided to strengthen such activities with the participation of management, local community and experts in this field.
